Due to the QRM I hardly ever play any music, Just make the station identification so that sometime during the ten minute period they will be sure to get the call.

The Xmitter here is a revamped Western Electric 301-B. The second and final amplifier has been changed to an 807 driving a pair of Eimac 250TL's grid modulated with a pair of 2A3's. 100 watts output, day and night, to a 150ft vertical ant.

That must have been me at 419 because Van Nostrand Radio engineering service Of Atlanta, Ga. measures our frequency.

Well old timer thanks again for the report and in case you care to listen for us again the sked is the third friday of every month at 3:10 to 3:20am CWT. Hope to hear from you again sometime.
