
We have had quite a few reports from that regular monthly test broadcast. In fact I have yet to make one that did not get a report. Quite a number of them have come from your state as well as from N.Y. Maine, Maryland, Penn. and other states in that general section of the country. The most remote point of one of the reports was from Quebec.

We have an old model RCA (BL 250) but it is very faithful and is about 70% efficient in power put into the final and effective power. the antenna is a 210' steel tower, set on a 3' base making it 213' feet overall. Of course the radiation is non-directional.

Hope that serves as the confirmation you requested. If I can be of further help please let me know.
