Thank you very much for your letter reporting reception of our test broadcast. We use an RCA transmitter and have a 203-foot-high antenna. Our call letters are KADL; we are operating on a frequency of 1270 kilocycles, with a power of 5000 watts.

We are not broadcasting commercially yet, but expect to before the first of September. When we officially go on the air, we will be a daytime station, operating during the daylight hours.
