
Dear DXer:

This will verify your report of reception of KSGN on the morning of March 14, 1950, from 12:34 to 1:01½ A.M., P.S.T. Many thanks for your report. Incidentally, the tone your heard, was no doubt emanating from our transmitter, as I was making noise and distortion measurements at the time and using the tone intermittently throughout the tests.

Equipment here consists of a Collins 20T 1 KW transmitter feeding a 285 foot Wincharger vertical radiator. Our transmitter is located in the Kings River bottom ¼ miles northeast of Sanger and 17 miles east of Fresno. Sanger is noted as the "Nations Christmas Tree City" due to the annual festival centered around the General Grant Tree. Fresno is the center of the worlds largest raisin and sweet wine producing area.

Again, many thanks for your report. DX reports such as yours are very helpful in keeping the transmitter operating at peak efficiency.
