I sigged off the rig at OlO5 P.S.T. though so you must have read KJAY in Kansas after that time. Several others have identified that station as coming on the air at about one (OlOO) P.S.T.

Too bad you couldn't have had better condx there...some of the fellows got exceptional results. Some didn't though. Apparently local interference in some cases was the cause and in others it was other stations QRM-ing the works. We'll hope for better next time.

Thanks very much for you report and I hope the burning off the early morning oil will be made up to you by this verification. This I beleive is my third (total) to you. One from KIBE in Palo Alto and two from here KVON.

Also had the pleasure of meeting a couple of your DX-ing buddies that night. Larry Yarnes and Gene Allen were in the studio and 'on mike' with me.
