This will acknowledge your recent letter and to verify your reception this station Feb. 10, 1952.

Your report coincides with our program log for the day, and we are pleased to make this acknowledgement.

WJWL operates on 900 with 1000 Watts, daytime only. Our tower is a 350 foot guyed stainless. Our ground system consists of 120 radials, 420 feet in length. The terrain here is flat, and stays damp, regardless of season. (closest thing to a swamp I've ever seen.) General Electric gear is used throughout.

Our FM set-up consists of a 3KW GE transmitter feeding a four bay Andrews Vee giving an ERP of 8200 Watts.
