Many thanks for your letter and tape concerning the receiving of our radio signals. It never ceases to amaze one when such a report is received.

A check of our program log and your tape confirms your report. We wish to extend appreciation thereof, and to commend you for the detail accuracy contained therein.

Without knowledge of the exact method you used to record our program, it is assumed that a microphone was placed in proximity to the radio receiver's loudspeaker. Our experience with this technique has shown that placement of the microphone as close to the loudspeaker cone as possible, and turning the volume very low, can help the clarity of the recording. So for what it is worth, we would like to pass this information along.
