Dear Mr. Morss:-

Thanks very much for your letter and report dated January 5th 1959. The time you stated, and also the program has been checked by us, and we are happy to report that you've listened to Radio Hoyer I, 1010 KCS - 297 M. on the morning of January 5th 1959.

Curacao time is indeed half an hour ahead of EST. We have two radio stations, namely "Radio Hoyer 1" 1010 KCS - 297 meters, and "Radio Hoyer 2" 1500 KCS - 200 meters. Both stations are on the air from 5 a.m. (Curacao time) to 11 p.m. daily. We've been receiving many listeners-reports from countries far away from us, and most of them, especially those in the U.S., state that the reception was at about 5 a.m. Curacao time. This proves that at that time the reception of our stations is best in the U.S., and we are very pleased that you've also been able to listen in, and that you liked the music played.

Mr. Morss, it was indeed a great pleasure hearing from you, and we do hope that you'll be able to tune in again to Radio Hoyer in the future.
