Thank you for your letter of the 2nd December.

We are very interested to hear of your long-distance reception of the BBC Home Service, and I am passing your letter to our Ionosphere Section for their consideration.

The frequency 1384 kc/s (216.8 metres) is used by two BBC stations situated at Clevedon (Somerset) and Bartley (Hampshire) which radiate the "West of England Home Service". Other frequencies used by us in the medium waves are 200, 668, 767, 804, 877, 977, 1013, 1050, 1149, and 1474 kc/s. The BBC's European is also carried in the medium waves on 658 and 1122 kc/s and also in the long waveband on 167 kc/s.

We trust this information will prove of some interest to you.
