We are pleased to confirm your reception of WSSA on November 5, 1973, between 4:52 and 5:08 PM. The tape you sent certainly confirmed that it was us you heard. Our operation is 5000 watts on 1570 Khz, daytime only. Our November sign-off time is 5:30 PM E.S.T.

Morrow, Georgia, if you are wondering, is a suburb of Atlanta, being only about 12 miles from the heart of the city. Our format is strictly country and western, the only station in the south Atlanta to use such a format

Incidentally, I had the pleasure of living in New England back in 1965, when I worked for WFEA, 5000 watt, 1370 Khz, in Manchester, N.H. I hope this letter will be a satisfactory report to verify your reception.
