This letter is in verification of your report sent to KDSN.

KDSN is located one-half mile south of Denison on U.S. Highways 141 & 59. KDSN stands for KEEP DENISON SMILING NICELY. The population of Denison is 5,000.

These tests are conducted each month to insure the monitor equipment is working properly. Our transmitter is a Gates 500 watt, Hi-Watter, fed to twin towers with 110 degree phase relationship between the two towers, which makes out pattern beamed to the north of Denison.

KDSN is an independent station with no network affiliation, our programing is local radio type, since this is a more or less farming community.

The staff consists of 5 announcers, 2 engineers and 2 secretaries.
