Am pleased to confirm your reception of our Proof of Performance Measurements Test in the early morning of March 25. The tone modulation you heard might have been 50, 100, 400, 1000, 5000, <sup>10</sup>7,500 cycles which we used in the test, or perhaps even another frequency which the consulting engineers might have used. Your report of station breaks very nearly coincided with what I logged in the transmitter log, so I don't believe there is any doubt about your contact, especially when you are sure you heard the words "Kendallville Indiana". We were on the air all the time you logged us too.

I have had one or 2 other reports from Mass. on frequency check transmissions, but so far yours is the only one we have received on the Performance Measurement test.
