WLRP is using a Raytheon RA-1000 transmitter which has been giving us very good service with the exception that right now we are troubled with a third harmonic. We haven't determined definitely where it is orignating from although I have a hunch it might be radiating from our guy wires, which, for some reason were cut to 50' lengths, which figures out to be a good third harmonic radiator.
