This was our regular monthly frequency monitoring schedule, which is the second Saturday of each month from 4:10 AM to 4:25 AM C.W.T.

The transmitter and studios are located on the tenth floor of a hotel. The antenna is a self supporting tower 180 feet high located atop the hotel, the overall height being 290 feet. The transmitter and speech equipment is manufactured by Collins Radio Company.
