Dear Mr. Morss:

In reply to your letter of Jan. 26, which I am just now getting around to answering, in regard to your report on reception of KWSK on the morning of Jan. 25, 1954, I can state that in all probability it was this station which you heard. The report on reception which you gave was rather indefinite on the identification and call letters. However, this station was on the air on that date from the time 12:30 AM to 12:50 AM CST for a monthly frequency check program with Commercial Radio Monitoring Co. in Kansas City, Missouri. During the period, 1500 cps tone modulation was used with station identification at sign on and sign off (12:35 and 12:50 AM). Your report mentions the sign on and signoff announcements, the tone modulation, but does not give complete identification by call letters. So I say that in all probability you heard this station. The report mentions correctly the frequency and power used.

Should you wish to try for a more complete report, KWSK is on the air regularly for frequency check at the same time every fourth Monday morning of every month. Our next check is this coming Week on February 22, 1954 beginning at 12:35 AM CST.
