Our broadcasting schedule is, as follows: 6:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M., Monday through Saturday...8:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. on Sunday. Our present frequency measurement schedule is on the fourth Sunday morning of each month, between 1:30 and 2:00 A.M.

WINN operates on 1240 K<sub>2</sub> with power of 250 watts and is the outlet of the AMERICAN BROADCASTING COMPANY in Louisville. Our studios and transmitter are located on the Tenth Floor of the Tyler Hotel, corner Third and Jefferson Streets, Louisville, Kentucky (R. O. Box 1588). Our transmitter is a 2500 Collins 200A, with Collins 35C Limiting Amplifier and Collins 12E Control Console, as speech input.

Other main equipment: Collins 40B Frequency Control Unit, General Radio Frequency Monitor and Modulation Monitor. Our Windcharger Vertical Antenna is located on the roof of the Tyler Hotel and is 152 feet high, with an overall height of 282 feet, the roof being 130 feet.
