Our broadcasting schedule is, as follows: 6:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M., Monday through Saturday...8:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. on Sunday. Our present frequency measurement schedule is on the fourth Sunday working of M.M. ponch, between 1:30 and 2:00 A.M.

WINN operates on 1200 %, with power of the Natte and is the outlet of the Alexand Defaniant for the National Value and Loveted on the Tenth Proof of the Pylor Estal, outled This and Jefferson Streets, Louisville Asstrato (A. C. 1588). Our transmitter is a 2500 collins above, with Vollins 360 Limiting Amplifier and Jollins 126 Control Values, a Absent input.

Other main equipment: Collins 408 Productory Control Unit, General Radia Frequency Mondor and Modulation Monitor. Our Windoharger Vertical Antoina is located on the roof of the Tyler Hotel and is 152 feet high, with an overall height of 282 feet, the roof being 130 feet.
