Dear Mr. Morss:

I am pleased to inform you that your reception report on WMRE has been confirmed. You are one of the many in your area who has reported receiving our signal, so welcome to the WMRE Fan Club. We are always happy to hear from our broadcast DX friends.

WMRE-AM is owned by Mariner Communications and licensed for 50 kilowatts around the clock. Our transmitter is a Harris MW-50B and is located in Waltham, Massachusetts, six miles west of our Boston studios and offices. We operate at an assigned frequency of 1510 kHz., with a two-tower directional pattern during the day, and a four-tower pattern at night. Because of the restrictions on where our signal may travel, WMRE is aimed primarily east during our night time hours. This is why our night time signal is frequently heard in Europe.

WMRE, formerly WITS, is an all-music nostalgia format. We feature hits of the 1940s, 1950s, and 1960s. We feature news right before the top of the hour. Because of our format, we are known as "The Memories Station."
