The signal went up in 1962 and was operated by Keynote Broadcasting thru the late 1970's. Several changes took place after the death of the station's owner and---for a short period of time---the signal went dark. It was picked up in the summer of last year by the current owner. The transmitter is still the original! Our signal is highly directional with our weakest points to the south and southeast (protecting the WPOP signal you mentioned).
