This is to verify your reception of our signal on 900 Kilocycles on Dec. 9, 1955 at 254 AM EST.

WCME operates on 900 kilocycles with a power of 250 watts, local sunrise to local sunset.

We use Gates equipment entirely with the exception of our controllroom mike which is an RCA 77D. We have the Gates SA 40 console, 250GY Gates transmitter, 3 Gates turntables, and Gates limiter and frequency monitor.

We have a 278 foot guyed tower which is shunt excited and fed by direct line from the transmitter.

We have an effective coverage of about 60 miles, which is excellent for a 250 watt station.

Sincerely hoping this completes your verification of Maine. We reMAINE.
