Thanks very much for your report on our signal reception on 2 February 1948, between 0409 and 0425. Your log entries correspond with our program log and therefore it gives me pleasure to verify your report of reception of WFAU.

We have been much gratified at the response to this program, having received letters from western New York and Pennsylvania and south to Maryland on the Atlantic seaboard and many points in between.

WFAU uses a Raytheon 250 watt transmitter feeding a quarter wave Windgharger guyed vertical radiator thru 425 feet of 7/8" co-axial line, and with a ground system of 120 quarter wave radials in fairly moist clay.

Our transmitter, control room, studios and offices are all located under one roof in a newly constructed building on a main highway about one mile from the heart of the city, and in a semi-commercial district.

Again, many thanks to you for the nice report, and the best of luck in your quest for DX.
