At the time you heard us, our station (970 kHz; 5-kw; daytime nondirectional, nighttime directional) had just been purchased by its present owners, Eastport Broadcasting Corp. On Valentine's Day, 1981, we switched our network affiliation to CBS and our format to the increasingly-popular syndicated taped "Music of Your Life" service (traditional Adult MOR pop hits of 1938-1975). Since then, we have added a superb four-person local news department. and have become the Greater Portland outlet for the Boston Red Sox, Boston Bruins, Boston Celtics, and New England Patriots.

We also co-own and operate a sister FM station, WYNZ-FM (100.9 MHz; 3-kw ERP), nicknamed "Y101", with a semi-automated soft adult rock format. Both stations are having tremendous impact in this market, much to the delight of many folks.

Thank you again. Mr. Morss, for your kind letter, and we hope you can tune us in again soon to enjoy the "Music of Your Life".
