Dear Friend DX'er:

This is to verify your W G R D reception
report of January 25, 1948, 5:05 - 5:27AM EST.
February 9, 1948, 3:26 - 3:43AM EST.
W G R D is an independent daytime station,
operating on a frequency of 1410 kilocycles with a
power of 1000 watts.

The studios, at 35 Lafayette, N. E., are
RCA equipped, while the transmitting plant, at 1300
Plymouth Rd., N. E., is Western Electric equipped.

The radiating system comprises a self-
supporting 200' Truscon tower, 120 ground radials
250' long, plus a 48' square copper mesh ground
screen directly underneath. The tower is series fed
from the transmitter by means of a pressurized 7/8"
copper coaxial line approximately 200' long. The
ground elevation is approximately 770' above sea
level.
