Confirming your DX letter of Dec 19, 1946.

At the time of your DXing this station was in the third day of its Equipment test and at the time we were playing music till 2Am and using a tone signal from 2Am till 2:15Am for the purpose of Frequency test. We began our regular broadcast schedule or program test December 15. So you can see we are a pretty new station.

We use all Raytheon equipment here in this station, RA-250 Transmitter and RC-11 console, 150 foot guyed series fed tower.

Havre is located, in case you arent familiar with this part of the country, about 30 miles from the Canadian border and right in the middle of the wheat and cattle ranching country. Incidentally, it gets rather cool here too.
