This will verify your reception report for the KFAL TEST TRANSMISSION on November 9th 1959, 230 to 300 AM CST.

The KFAL Transmitter is a Collins 20F(Modified), feeding a Quarter-wave vertical antenna system, with a Quarter-wave radial ground system of 120 buried copper wires.

The Transmitter site is situated in the northwest section of Fulton, Missouri, about 1.3 miles from the "downtown" section of the City. Studios are downtown, close to the business section. Fulton is a city of 12500 population, (estimated) the historical capital of the Kingdom of Callaway, and county seat of Callaway County. It is the center of a large fire-clay mining area, and a rich farming and cattle raising country. Fulton is on U S Highway 54, about 6 miles south of U S Highway 40, near the middle of the State of Missouri, and is the home of Westminster College(for men) and William Woods College(for women).
