In answer to your verification of our program of August 19, we are very glad to verify your report as being correct.

We are using Raytheon equipment throughout, we have the RA 1,000 transmitter with a 356' vertical radiator, shunt-fed, and a ground system consisting of 120 radials terminating in a 48' square copper mesh, with an additional mat of 48' square under the transmitter building bonded to the main ground system.
