
WTMN has a long history at 1380 kHz in Portsmouth. The station was originally WBBX from 1960 through 1985. From late 1985 through January of 1987, it was an oldies station - WAVI. It went dark for a few months and returned in May of 1987 as WQMI, under new ownership. At this time, it became the sister station of WQMI-FM (95.3 MHz, York Center, Maine). The stations were sold to Sunshine Group Broadcasting in April of 1989 and continued under that ownership until August of 1994 at which time they were purchased by Knight Quality Stations (WHEB, Portsmouth, NH, WGIR AM/FM, Manchester, NH, WSRS/WTAG, Worcester, MA, WEZF, Burlington, VT).

WTMN carries the One on One Sports Network as it's primary programming. We also carry the Fabulous Sportsbabe weekdays from 10-2, and are Seacoast affiliates for the New England Patriots, Boston College Eagles (FB and hockey) and the Boston Bruins.

We broadcast from studios at 1555 Islington Street, Portsmouth, NH using a Harris MW-1 transmitter. We are 1000 watts and directional to the north at night. Our towers are visible from I-95, behind the Portsmouth Hospital.
