Dear Mr. Morss:

I am glad to hear that our auxiliary transmitter, which run 250 watts, reaches you. On Sunday we sign on at 6:25 a.m., which is the reason you heard nothing after the conclusion of our test.

wHVw operates during the daytime only on a frequency of 950 kilocycles with 500 watts of non-directional power. we use a Collins kilowatt transmitter which is loaded down to 500 watts in order to meet the terms of our license. Our antenna system consists of a single 240 foot tower.

Enclosed you will find a certificate of QSL for the report which you sent us. I hope you'll be able to listen to us more often.
