Dear Mr. Morss:

It is indeed a pleasure for me to verify your report of WSAY's reception on the morning of January 18, 1954.

This verification is being made only after a careful check of our station log and I find that your report for the period monitored was accurate in every detail.

For your information and future reference, WSAY at the present time is operating on a power out-put of 1,000 watts with a figure "8" directional pattern both day and night with suppression to the East and West and greatest power to the North and South. In the summer, we expect to go on the air with the 5,000 watt transmitter, non-directional in the daytime and a similar figure "8" directional pattern during the night.

Both our present 1,000 watt transmitter and our new 5,000 watt transmitter are manufactured by the Radio Corporation of America. The new 5,000 watt transmitter is of the latest type and has many new innovations which will allow high modulation with little or no distortion.

It is proposed that as soon as this new equipment is in operation we will arrange with the National Radio Club to conduct another special DX program.

In closing, I'd like to take this opportunity to thank you for your accurate, detailed report of our reception, with the hope that sometime in the near future our WSAY facilities will be of further service to you.
