Thank you for your letter dated February 20, 1959. After having checked your letter against our program log I found your letter correct so I am sending this verification of reception.

WVOX (formerly WWES) operates on a frequency of 1460 kc. with a power of 500 watts and WVOX-FM (WWES-FM) operates on a frequency of 93.5 mc. with a power of 1000 watts. As of February 27th our call is WVOX. I am sorry that I didn't reply to your letter sooner but we are in the process of moving our studios to the transmitter site and I have been quite busy with the wiring.

WVOX, WVIP, WSKN, and pending FCC approval WKIT, make up the Herald Tribune radio Network. Once again thank you for your report.
