This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated Aug. 1st. for which we thank you.

I hope you will excuse us for not answering your reception report of Feb. 15th. Several reports at that time were misplaced and we are sorry to say went unanswered. I want to thank you for bringing this to my attention.

We began our regular broadcast schedule on Feb. 20th. We are on the air each day from 5:30 A.M. till 1:05 A.M. the next morning. On Sundays we begin at 7:00 A.M. and again close down at 1:05 A.M. the following morning.

For equipment, we are using an RCA Type BTA-250L transmitter. Our tower is a self-supporting type Truscon 150 ft. high. All audio equipment is Western Electric.
