WGOR is pleased to be able to verify your reception of our station on 7 March 1977 between 0250--312 based on information sent to us in your letter.

Some information about our station:
WGOR is an Unlimited Hours Standard Broadcast station operating on a Class II-B Channel on 1520 Khz, 197 meters, with 1000 watts both day and night.
WGOR operates with different Directional Patterns from Day to Night. WGOR is one of several US stations which operate with two transmitter sites. During daytime hours we operate from Temperance, Michigan with a six tower array on a bearing of 170° towards Toledo and southward. At night, as when you logged WGOR, we operate from Perrysburg, Ohio with another six tower array on a bearing of 0° towards Toledo and northward.


Our studios, formerly in downtown Toledo, are now at the Daytime Transmitter site. Our day transmitter is a Gates BC1H1; our nighttime transmitter is a Gates Vanguard I.

Our programming is Religious, Gospel Music with ethnic programs on Saturday. We are affiliated with the Mutual Network. We operate a full 7 day-24 hour schedule.

WGOR became the call letters in July 1976. Our previous call letters being WTTO, WTUU, and WANR. We are owned by the Gore Broadcasting, Inc of Ft Lauderdale, Florida.
