WHOF came into being on October 15, 1961,  
after changing its call letters from WCMW. We  
are non-directional with 1000 watts power, daytime  
hours only.

Our transmitter at present is an RCA type  
1-G, PP833A final, and PP833A Class AB-1 modulators.  
Our radiator is 120 degrees electrical height,  
giving us a low angle of radiation with very  
little sky wave.
