Dear Mr. Morss:

This is to confirm your report of reception of our signals on November 13, 1949, at 6:09 AM.

Our transmitter is an RCA BTA-250-L feeding directly into a Trylong 150 foot guyed tower. The ground system consists of 120 radials, 200 feet long. The transmitter is located approximately one mile west of East Liverpool, on what is said to be the highest point visible from the Ohio River at any place.

Our studios are located on the "Diamond" in downtown East Liverpool-equipment there is also RCA.

Our testing schedule is indefinite due to WWSW's occupancy of this frequency.
