Thank you for your DX letter relative to your reception of WJAR.

After checking the program log, there is no doubt that you had WJAR on 1110 kc.

This station is a new daytime 500 watt, which started operation August 15, 1946. Transmitter is Gates BC1E, with 833A'S in Parallel for the P.A., and 833A'S in pushpull for the modulation. The antenna is a quarter wave vertical, series feed, 227 feet high, making the total height above sea level 492 feet.

We appreciate your interest in us and hope you will become a regular listener.
