Dear Stan;

Sorry to be late in answering your request for verification of reception report. Being busy putting the station on the air last October resulted in the misplacement of quite a bit of mail and I imagine some of it is still lost.

From your letter I gather you received us at that time when we were checking out the audio equipment, making field intensity measurements, and perhaps frequency checks. I hope that you will take these into account for the delay.

As to the titles of the music we were playing at the time you received us I cannot verify them as to title. I do know that all we did was play music and announce station call sign and FCC permit number every fifteen minutes. This of course you have indicated on the letter you sent.

WTH T is on an assigned frequency of 1300 kcs. at a power of 1000 watts. All equipment is Collins and is as follows. The transmitter is a Collins 20V2 feeding a Collins phaser into two two hundred foot towers spaced approximately 400 ft. apart and fed 60 degrees out of phase giving a directional pattern as indicated on the inclosed coverage map. The audio in turn is fed from a Collins control console having 14 inputs. We have three Rek-o-kut turn tables, two spotmasters, and a tape deck in addition to the remote lines etc..,

We began broadcasting on October 25, 1961 so you got us before programming. Should there be any other information I will send it to you on request, and I might add, more prompt.
