Dear Mr. Moss,

Thank you so much for putting in the "late hours" to hear our test. It was an interesting experiment to seek Stateside listeners. Reception reports came to us from six different states. According to the reports we didn't boom-in, but our signal was recognized and logged.

This letter is to confirm that the information you sent regarding the WCGB test program of December 6, 1971 at 2:00-2:30 a.m. AST conforms to our log.

WCGB is a daytime station on 1050 Khz with 1000 watts of power. Located on the south coast of Puerto Rico, near Juana Diaz, WCGB programs in Spanish with the exception of one and a half hours of English programs at mid-day. Owned by Grace Mission, Inc. of Grand Rapids, Michigan, our purpose is to present Jesus Christ as the Answer to man's need. We program popular music of the slower, lighter style (Spanish Bolero) along with five-minute special Christian messages and some regular religious programs of various denominations. Our antenna is located in a marshy area often under salt water. Thus we have good response from most of the Island of Puerto Rico. Having just celebrated our fourth anniversary on Thanksgiving Day we are very pleased with the acceptance to our broadcast service in this area.

If you're ever on vacation in this area be sure to stop and see us. Until then, good luck in your DXing. Thanks again for your response to our test.
