

My Dear Mr. Morse:

Thanks very much for your reply to our Program Test on Sunday morning, January 14, 1951, 5:15-5:30 AM, Eastern Standard Time. I'm very pleased to know that our little 250 watt peanut whistle blows that hard. The rig here runs 348 watts input to a pair of 810's, modulated with same. Transmitter is a Gates BC 250 GY. Frequency monitor, modulation monitor, limiter and console also belongs to Brother Gates and Family. Smaller power of 15 watts CW licensed as W4ROL signs on 40 meters and can also be heard from Greer after WEAB signs off at sunset.
