Dear Mr. Moses;

I received your letter of October 12 today and am very happy to confirm your report. According to my records this is the first letter we have received here from Mass. but my files are not complete as far as I know. I have only been Chief Engineer here just about a year now.

On March 9 of this year we received a letter from New Zealand stating they heard our freq check of that day.

We have an RCA 250-K transmitter operating on 250 watts day and night. Our studio and measuring equipment is about all R.C.A.

Our frequency checks are given every 2nd Friday of each month from 3:50 AM to 4:00 AM E.S.T. The broadcast regularly from 7:00 AM to 11:15 PM.

Last Friday morning it was a clear sky and the temp. was around 60°F.

I hope that we may hear from you fellows up in that direction on future checks.
