We are pleased to verify your report on receiving our frequency check May 27th, 1946. W.K.I.X. checks frequency every Monday morning from 3.35 to 3.45 EST.

Our transmitter is located on the edge of Columbia, South Carolina. Our transmitter is a revamped Signal Corps Xtrmr. using a 807 crystal oscillator, a 807 buffer and driver, and a pair of parallel 805's in the final, and the modulator is a pair of 8II's in push pull.

Speaking in behalf of the rest of the transmitter crew, we thank you for your report for it is gradifying to know that we are getting out, especially under the above setup.
