Dear Mr. Morss,

I was very happy indeed to receive a report of the reception of the test program in your city of Bradford, Massachusetts.

Before I forget it let me say that your log of the activities on the test broadcast were entirely correct and I am happy to send along this verification.

The equipment used here is Collins throughout and the antenna is a 267 foot guyed steel tower.

The town of Hamilton has a population of about 5000 and is sustained chiefly by agriculture and livestock raising. The town is located about 50 miles from the center of the Lone Star State.

The mail response to the test has been very good and it looks like I'll wear out the old typewriter ribbon before I finish all the correspondence. (Hi)

In closing, thanks once again for your report and hope to hear from you in the near future.
