Dear Mr. Morss,

After checking station records, I am pleased to verify your reception of WMZQ-AM on January 28, 1987.

WMZQ-AM is licensed to Arlington Virginia (a suburb of Washington DC) and is owned by VIACOM broadcasting. VIACOM also owns six FM and two AM stations around the country. Up until 1984, WMZQ-AM went under call of WEAM.

WMZQ-AM operates at a power level of 5000 watts, directional, 24 hours a day using the new 100% solid state Nautel, Amphet-5 transmitter. We broadcast in stereo using the Motorola "C-Quam" AM stereo system.

Here in Washington, we have a sister station, WMZQ-FM licensed to Washington DC. Both stations are country music stations and both serve the Washington DC metropolitan area. We are affiliated with the AP network for news and information and WMZQ-AM takes some of its programming from the Satellite Music Network.

We receive about four to five receiption reports a year mostly from the northeast US. The most distant report came from Germany in about 1978. That was very unusual.
