
Thank you for your recent report of reception of WVEC on our test broadcast January 29, 1949 between the hours of 3:03 AM and 3:34 AM EST.

Your report checks with our log and you may consider this letter a confirmation of your reception.

WVEC operates on 1050 Kilocycles with a power of 250 watts. WVEC uses a Raytheon RA-250 transmitter, and a steel vertical radiator 225 feet in height, series fed. We are located on the lower peninsula of Virginia on historic Hampton Roads, the world's greatest harbor.
