This will verify your report of reception of Station KALE November 18th, 1952 at 1:04AM Pacific Standard Time. KALE operates 24 hours a day, 6 days a week, with an off-the-air period for maintenance from Midnight Sunday to 6AM Monday morning. Have been getting a number of reception reports from the Eastern Seaboard, incidentally, all members of the National Radio Club, which is quite amazing since we operate with a directional system at night which puts our primary signal into the northwestern part of Washington and only about half of our normal daytime signal in your direction. But I guess stranger things have been known to happen in radio.
