For your information, KVI's transmitter is located on Vashon Island in Puget Sound - seven miles west of Seattle.

The antenna is 444 feet high, and the entire ground system is in salt water, which accounts for the tremendous coverage of the station.

Our broadcast days starts at 6:00 AM and ends at 12:00 Mid-night daily - Sunday 7:30 AM to 12 Midnight (Pacific Standard Time).
