Dear Stan:

Thank you for your report of reception on January 10th. Your report is correct, as I was operating the station myself. I was testing a new control console which was put in to service at that time. A more or less regular program of testing is in effect here at WEKZ. That is the last Saturday morning of each month during the experimental period. That would be from 0000 to about 0400 CST. I usually put the transmitter on the air and make a frequency run of the equipment, play a few cowboy and old-time records, etc. I have in the making, a dummy antenna which will allow me to check the equipment without radiating a signal (and by the way not stay up at such an ungodly hour in the morning) but there will still be times, of course, when a check of the whole station including the antenna will be necessary.

You may hear me once in a while on 75 meter phone talking to the boys.
