We are glad to confirm the reception of our broadcast of 29 November 1966 at 4:44 p.m.


We were operating at a power of 1,000 watts, and it is quite unusual to receive a reception report from such a distance. This should be quite a find for your DX activities.

We are a new station operating with 1,000 watts during critical hours and 10,000 watts daytime. We began operation November 14th, and so would not be listed in Whites Log or any of the other DX publications.
