I am pleased to confirm your reception report of CHQT in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada at 880 KHZ from 1.02-11:05 to 1:24am 1:30 (DIC 7/86)

CHQT Radio at 880 KHZ operates in AM STEREO using the Motorola "C-QUAM" system, at a day time power of 50 kw omni-directional, and a night time power of 50 kw directional. Our transmitter site is located southease of the city and consists of a three tower array, giving us a coverage area of approximately a 150 mile radius around Edmonton.

Beginning in 1965 as a 10 kw station at 1110 KHZ with a minimal staff, CHQT Radio has grown steadily to become a 50 kw AM Stereo station with a change in frequency to 880 KHZ in 1986 and studios and a staff of 45 people located on the 22nd floor of a downtown office building.

CHQT AM Stereo gears its programming to the adult listeners in our coverage area. We play easy listening music in full AM Stereo, with a minimum of talk by the Announcers. We also place heavy emphasis on News and Information.

It is always most interesting and informative to hear from a distant listener and I would like to thank you for your reception report.
