As you can no doubt tell by the amount of time it took us to reply to your letter, we get a tremendous amount of mail from all over the world from CKSA listeners. For some reason our 10,000 watt signal really covers a lot of ground. Most of our letters come from Finland and Greenland.

The closest I have ever travelled to Colorado would have to be when I saw Yellowstone National Park, six years ago ... we Canadians don't spend a lot of time in the U.S.. You see our "dollar" is worth only about 73¢ American, so a trip south gets very expensive.

Lloydminster is a community of 15,000, about $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours east of Edmonton, Alberta in the heart of some of the world's richest oilfields and farmland. Our city is the only one in Canada to be split by a provincial border. 50th Avenue divides Alberta and Saskatchewan. CKSA studios are about 100 yards inside the Alberta border.
