Thank you very much for your report of reception of WJLD from 2:00am to about 2:20am CST on January 10, 1955. Your report corresponds with our log. Please Except this letter as a VERIFICATION of WJLD. *WJLD*

So far, we have received about 45 reports from the United States, and 5 from New Zealand. Man. I didn't think we'd get out that far!!!

It may interest you to know that WJLD's transmitter is a Collins 300-G and the studios are all RCA equipped. The tower is 300 feet high being shunt fed. The pattern is non-directional.

Thanks again for your report and here's wishing you the best of the better brand of DX in the future. See you at the convention.
